A PHASED APPROACH



PRE-PHASE (P0): PROJECT IDENTIFICATION, PROJECT DESIGN, BASELINE DATA COLLECTION

PHASE I (PI): SITE CONDITIONING

PHASE 2 (P2): CANOPY ESTABLISHMENT

PHASE 3 (P3): FOREST BIODIVERSITY ENRICHMENT

PHASE 4 (P4): CONSERVATION

ARC's phased approach is informed by decades of project implementation experience shared among our team members. This approach divides the stages of a restoration site's lifespan into clear, manageable, and measurable goals and benchmarks. The ultimate goals are as follows: the establishment of ecologically functional forests, the improvement of socioeconomic conditions of communities through employment, and investment into long-term, sustainable solutions that benefit the communities.

Each phase includes a reporting structure that keeps our valued partners fully informed on progress within the project site and allows the partners to take part in the joy of watching a forest be reborn.

PROGRESS REPORTS: QUARTERLY AND ANNUALLY

Annual reports will include:

- A summary of operations
- The goals and benchmarks that were met toward the completion of a project phase
- The total number of trees planted categorized by species
- The number of employees hired to date and working days provided
- Geotagged or augmented location overlay photos within shareable albums of site activities
- Site-specific stories that connect sponsors to on-theground operations
- A view of areas that have been planted or are actively being planted
- Wildlife documented within the site
- Forest composition and health analysis (P2, P3, P4)
- Detailed photos and a narrative of site activities documented over the project phase
- Next steps toward site restoration and conservation
